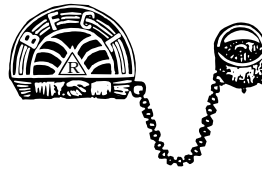
In May we will try to honor our Esther as she was ill last meeting and also a surprise honoree.
