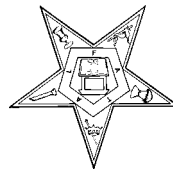

The stated meeting will also be election of officers. Installation of officers is scheduled to be held on January 10 at 7 PM.

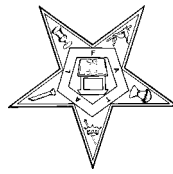

Our first meeting of the term will be January 15 at 7:00 and will be an instructional meeting for our new officers.

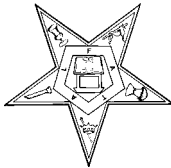
Hey, any of you Daughters who have not yet paid your dues, dues are due before installation in the amount of \$25 for the year! Don't forget!
