where they dine on German Sausage and Beer.

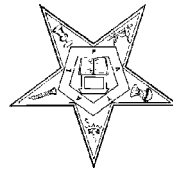

We are pleased to welcome Bro. Israel Mojica as a member of our Lodge. He received his first degree of masonry on November 14th.

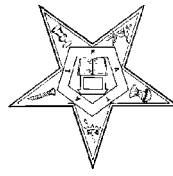

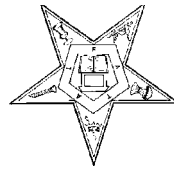
