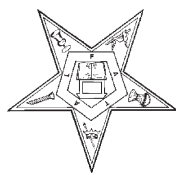

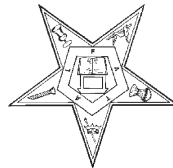
HLs & SKs,

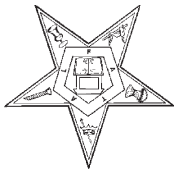

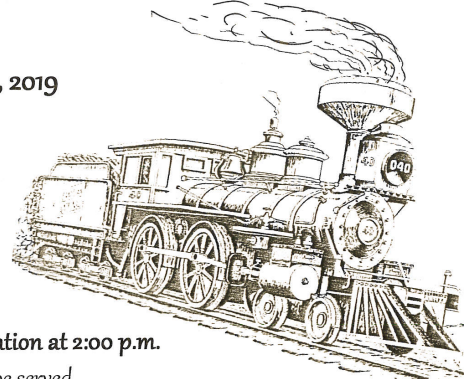
