August 13—Band meeting, 7pm at the home of Noble Ziggy - 2812 Harrison Ave., Eureka

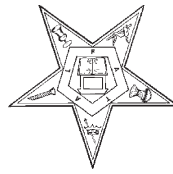
August 19—Clown meeting, 7pm at the home of Noble Jim Widdoes, 2879 Shields Lane Fortuna

## Scottish Rite Valley of Northern California

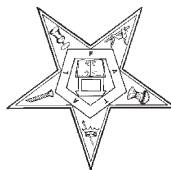
Brethren,
