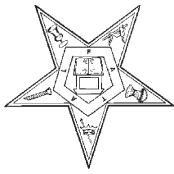

## Bethel No. 86, Job's Daughters

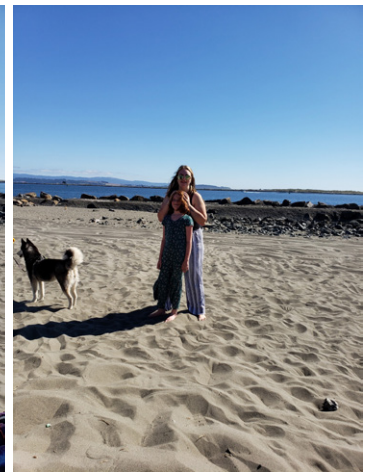
Happy Summer everyone!

## Eel River Empire Lodge No. 147

### History Continued:

On May 5, 1936 this Lodge celebrated its Diamond Jubilee of or 75th Anniversary, with appropriate ceremonies. All of the lodges of the First Masonic District were invited and were represented by a large gathering. The gathering was attended by sixty four officers and members of the several lodges represented. Earl Warren, Grand Master of California, was a guest at the dinner. Following the dinner, the members adjourned to the Veterans Memorial Building at Fortuna where the program was held. Following a number of vocal and instrumental selections, Brother R. L. Harris gave a brief resume of the history of the Lodge, which was followed by Brother Arthur Gist of Arcata with a few highlights on the history of Humboldt County. The evening was concluded with a splendid address by Brother Earl Warren, Grand Master of California.

Here the Lodge continued to prosper until February 12, 1938 when the matter of again owning our own Temple was presented for discussion and consideration and the Worship Master, Brother B. B. Marshall appointed a committee to investigate the purchase a building on the north side of Main Street Between 9th and 10th Street. The building was purchased from Dr. H. W. Comfort, a member of this Lodge, for the sum of \$6700.00. Paul M. Smook, also a member of this Lodge, was appointed as the architect on the job. (At the time, Paul Smook was the Resident Engineer for the Pacific Lumber Company in Scotia). The building was completely remodeled and furnished at a total cost of \$23,182.40. The Lodge found it was necessary to borrow only \$5,000 to complete the building. Of this amount only \$2,000 remains unpaid. (1942)

The first meeting in our new Temple was held on December 10, 1938 and from the minutes of that meeting we quote "In commemoration of our first meeting in our new Temple the Lodge was called from labor to refreshment and the

brethren were entertained with a number of vocal and instrumental selections followed a presentation by Brother Arthur Gist of Arcata. The Lodge was then called from refreshment to labor again and business was proceeded with".

Such briefly is the history of your Eel River Lodge. However, the real story of your Lodge is to be found in the written records, much of it between the lines, a story of those hardy pioneers seeking to hew civilization out of the wilderness, seeking security and safety for themselves and families, a story interesting in the extreme. Much of it cannot be quoted.

We are disappointed that the Annual Masonic Picnic couldn't be held this year as planned. It had been approved by the Grand Lodge, County and City, but shortly after the last Trestleboard was sent to print, the Grand Lodge withdrew approval. Everyone stay safe and healthy.

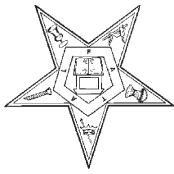

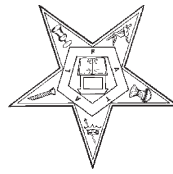

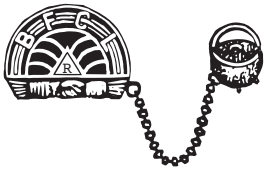


## Ferndale Chapter No. 23

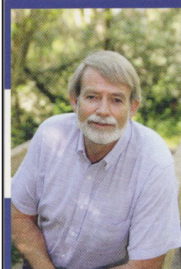
