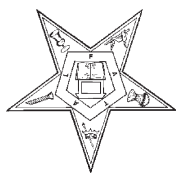

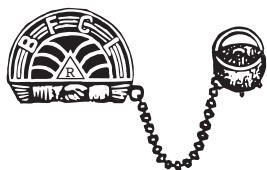

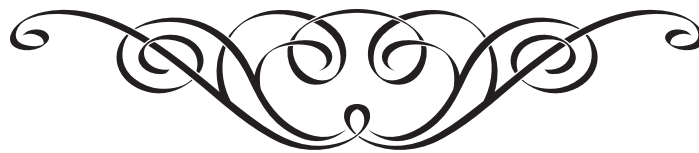
Hello Members and Friends:

Have a happy Valentine's Day! Flowers and roses are in order, but don't eat too many chocolates in one day! Keep safe and happy!

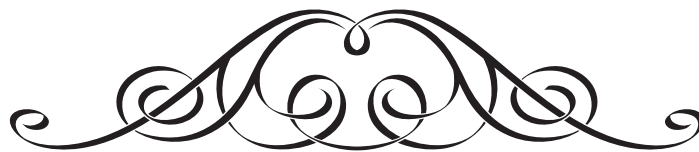

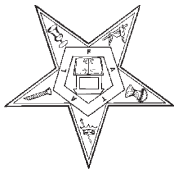

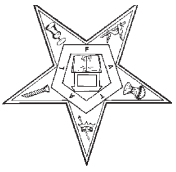
Nobles and Ladies:

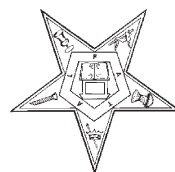

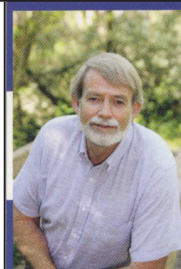
