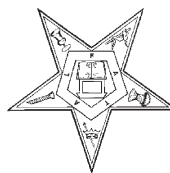

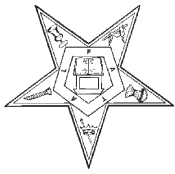

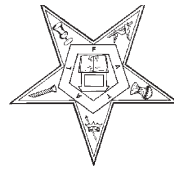


## Aahmes Redwood Shrine Club & Djinn's Band

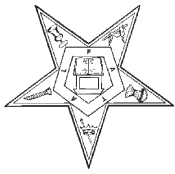
We are looking forward to our virtual Grand Bethel at the end of June and watching it together.

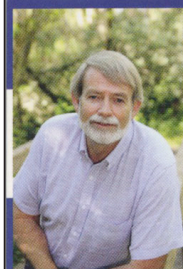
