Brethren,

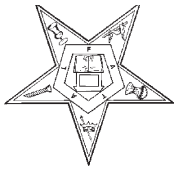

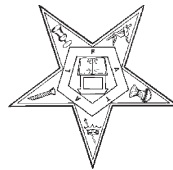
## Arcata Chapter No. 207

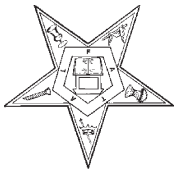

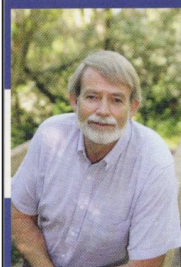
