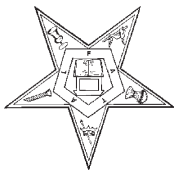

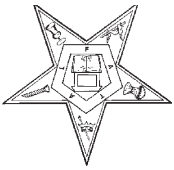

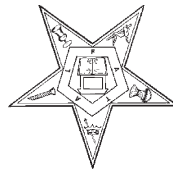

Congratulations to Sr. Princess Anisha who just made her high school JV softball team!

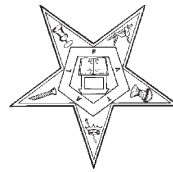
