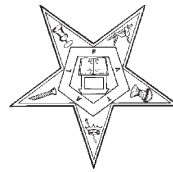

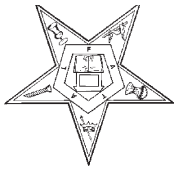

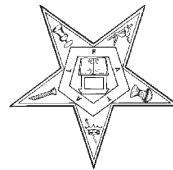

The Saturday before Easter, homemade cookie plates were made and delivered to 50-year members, shut-ins and various members of our Masonic family. Thank you to everyone who helped.

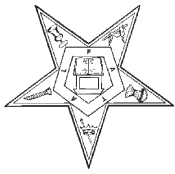

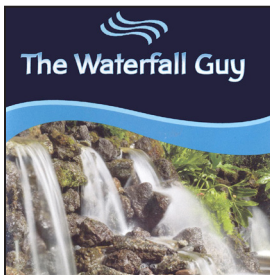

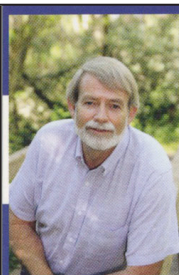
