Greetings Brethren,

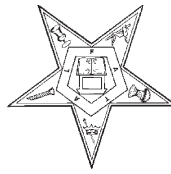

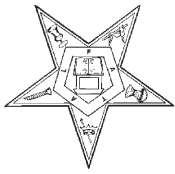

We have two \$1000 scholarships to be presented to recipients as soon as the committee has made their choice.

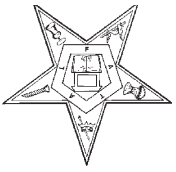

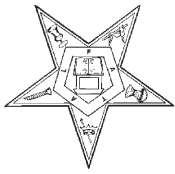
