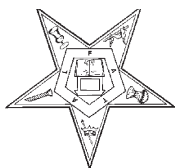

Hi everyone!

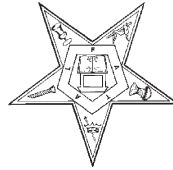

As a Grand Officer, I thought it might be nice to show you my thought speech from our most recent meeting! Here it is...

"As you more than likely know, today's date is 7/11 making it National slurpee day, the one day of the year where you can walk into any 7/11 and get a free frozen treat. However, a national holiday that you might not know about takes place tomorrow, on July 12. This day is called Malala day. If you are here at this meeting tonight, I am sure you know that a key goal in California Rainbow is to prepare the girls of today to be the leaders of tomorrow. Although Malala Yousafzai may not have been in Rainbow, she has clearly shown that she is a leader. Because of this and the fact that Malala Day is tomorrow, I thought I'd tell you a bit more about who she is and why I see her as such an inspiration. 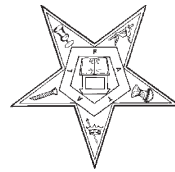

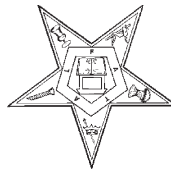
My Brothers,
