The following revisions to our By-Laws have been suggested by the By-Laws committee. They will be voted on at the next stated meeting. If you have questions please contact Karen Parlato, Sec. at 707 725-3532.

### ARTICLE II MEETINGS

Sec. 1. The stated meetings of this Chapter shall be held at the  
**Eel River Empire Masonic Lodge**  
**922 Main Street**  
**Fortuna, California**

on the second Thursday in each month at 7:30 o'clock P.M.; provided, however, no meeting shall be held on the days designated for the annual session of the Grand Chapter, nor on the day prior to the formal opening, or the day following the close, of the annual session, **nor in July.**

### ARTICLE V FEES AND DUES

Sec. 2. The annual dues of each member shall be **the amount of the Grand Chapter annual per capita fees and special assessments plus thirty dollars.**

The annual dues shall be paid in advance in full on January 1.

Nonpayment of due and/or assessments shall subject a member to penalties prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of the Grand Chapter.


Sec. 3 Life Membership shall be **on a sliding fee according to member's age:**

<b>Under 50 years</b>	<b>21 times the amount of Grand Chapter annual per capita fees and special assessments plus, Chapter dues</b>
<b>50 – 54 years</b>	<b>19 (same as above)</b>
<b>55 – 59 years</b>	<b>17 (same as above)</b>
<b>60 – 64 Years</b>	<b>14 (same as above)</b>
<b>65 years and up</b>	<b>11 (same as above)</b>

### ARTICLE VI COMMITTEES

Sec. 1. The Worthy Matron, at her installation, shall appoint the following committees:

(a) A Relief Committee to consist of the Worthy Matron, Worthy Patron, Associate Matron and Associate Patron... The Committee shall have the power to draw upon the treasury, without vote of the Chapter, a sum not exceeding **two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00)**, if required before the next stated meeting for emergency relief of a needy member in good standing.

## Humboldt Chapter No. 52 Royal Arch Masons

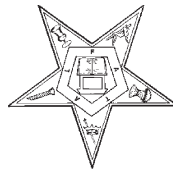
Stated Convocations Second Wednesday

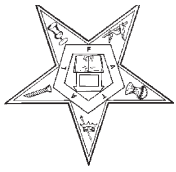
