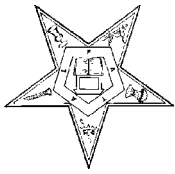

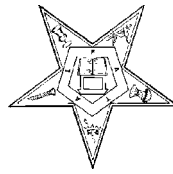


Congratulations are in order as well to our new DGM Lisa McCombs! We wish you a fun-filled year and know that you will represent District one well!

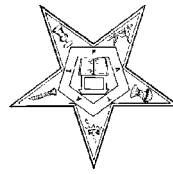

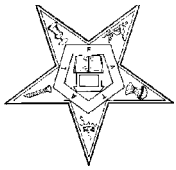
