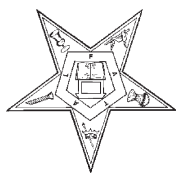



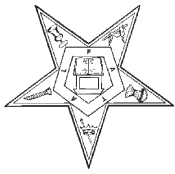
Hello Brethren,

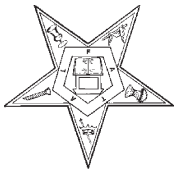
