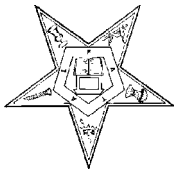

Greetings Sisters and Brothers

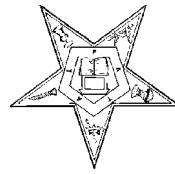

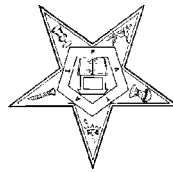
Grand Bethel is fast approaching as well. This year grand Bethel is June 27-July 1 in Ontario.

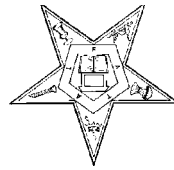


## Humboldt Lodge No. 79

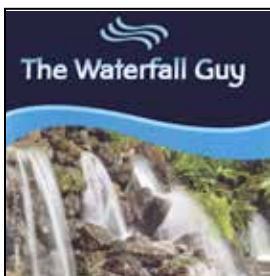
