

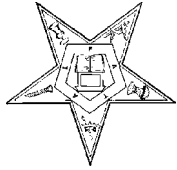

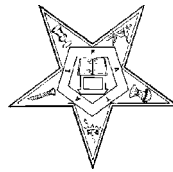


# Humboldt Lodge No. 79

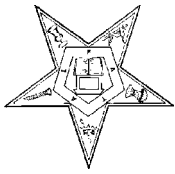

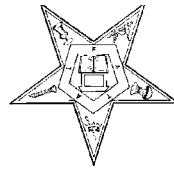

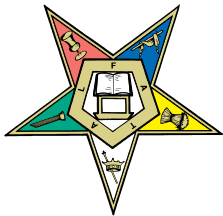
